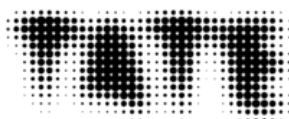

Dear Parent/Carer



We have arranged for Year 10 Art and Photography students to visit the Tate Modern Gallery, London, on **Tuesday, 27 September 2016**. The visit will enable students to understand and interpret a wide range of thought provoking works, by various national and international artists, including important masterpieces. This experience is an integral part of the syllabus for their GCSE course, which enriches their studies by giving them a greater knowledge of modern and contemporary art.

We will leave school at 9.00am prompt. Students will be transported by coach; the coach is fitted with seatbelts and students will be expected to wear them. The group will aim to return to School by 3.00pm, road traffic conditions permitting. Please make arrangements for your son/daughter to travel home safely from school in the event that the coach is delayed. Students will need to bring a disposable packed lunch, including water (no fizzy drinks or nuts) and students are required to wear full school uniform.

To enhance the benefits of this trip further, we would, where possible, like the students to bring a camera and/or a mobile phone to allow them to take photographs to help document their trip. This will be especially beneficial to Photography students so we would very much encourage this. The camera/mobile phone will, however, be the student's responsibility and will only be used as directed by the teacher.

The total cost of this trip will be £9.00. Please make your payment using ParentPay (www.parentpay.com), our online payment system, choosing the service 'Tate Modern Visit 27 09 2016'. All students participating in this event must return the reply slip, together with the Parental Consent Form and pay on or before **Monday, 12 September 2016**. **N. B. WE EXPECT THIS TRIP TO BE EXTREMELY POPULAR; THEREFORE PLACES WILL BE ALLOCATED ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS.**

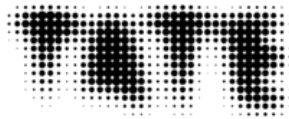
