

Most able home works for photography

Key stage 3

- Shadow art—photograph shadows around your home—you might need to use a light source such as a torch to help you
- Letter photography—photograph the letters from your name from objects you see around you
- Take photos through doors and windows—use the door and window frame to frame the image
- Write a letter to your favourite photographer, what are you asking them? What would you like to know and find out? What intrigues you about the photo?

Key stage 4

- Tell a story in 12 photos
- Create a research booklet based on a contemporary photographer of your choice. The booklet should include 6 images, 1 photographers interview or 1 review of the photographers work and 4 quotes. Re create one of the photographers pieces in your own way
- Choose 1 word which represents you and create a series of photos which reflect this word

Key stage 5

- Create a writing frame which will help you and your peers write about the photographers work. What would you like to ask the photographer? What would you like to find out?
- Re create a newspaper article through a photo
- Write down different states of mind and represent one of these through a series of photographs, e.g. How can you represent determination, Insecurities, fear, aspirations?
