Dear Parents and Carers

Over the past few weeks and as the weather has begun to get a bit colder, we have noticed students have been wearing non-school uniform clothing at school.

Please could I remind you and ask that you reinforce with your son/daughter that our school uniform expectations are as follows:

- Ties and blazers on
- Shirts tucked in
- No jewellery (items will be confiscated until the end of the week)
- Appropriate school shoes (black shoes, not boots)
- No hoodies (including PE hoodies which should only be worn in PE lessons) - SWRS Jumpers and Cardigans are available from [Sportcrest](#)
- Coats should be removed in lessons

We are aware that some of our classrooms are colder because we are ensuring that there is a constant air flow by propping open external doors: this is one of our Covid-19 health and safety measures to keep students and staff safe. Where this is the case, teachers will allow students to keep their coats on in colder weather. This will not be the case in classrooms that do not have an external door.

If your son/daughter is concerned that they will become very cold at school, they should wear additional layers under their school uniform to keep themselves warm. Please note that **NO** hoodies, including the [SWR PE kit hoodie](#) can be worn over a student's school uniform or under a school blazer.
