Re: Exam Leave and Arrangements

We are writing with details of arrangements for Year 11 exam leave and the exam season.

As you will be aware the GCSE examinations begin on the 16th May. From this date until further notice, all Year 11 students are expected to be in all lessons when they do not have an examination.

The final day for Y11 students will be confirmed at a later date. On that day all Year 11 students will attend a leavers' assembly which will provide an opportunity for them to celebrate their hard work and share memories with staff and each other, finishing school at 3pm as normal.

Attached is a timetable that shows all of the Summer GCSE examinations up until half term. In Red, it also shows compulsory revision sessions that are being held in school time just prior to that subject's examination. These are designed as a last minute refresher for the students. We are also offering breakfast clubs for certain subjects; these can be found in the breakfast club column. They will be held in the far side of Café Ramsay from 8am onwards; food will be available for students to purchase whilst revising with a member of staff.

In the final column on the sheet 'WTM' this stands for Walking Talking Mocks; this is where an experienced member of staff goes through an entire GCSE paper question by question with the students. This will give the students a fantastic opportunity to work through an entire paper, giving them a refresher on how to answer certain questions and what the mark schemes are looking for.

During the May half term, some subjects will be offering revision sessions to assist the Year 11's. Please also find this timetable attached.

Timetabled BTEC lessons will also continue until your son's/daughter's work has been completed and all relevant BTEC paperwork has been signed by both the teacher and student. Please be aware this can continue past the Year 11's Final Day if deemed necessary.

To celebrate all of the students' hard work, the Year 11 Prom will take place on Friday 24th June at High Wycombe Town Hall. Students should arrive from 6.30pm, with the meal being served at 7pm, and finishing promptly at 10.45pm.
