Dear Parent/Carer

Important Dates for Year 12

I would like to take this opportunity to remind Year 12 Students and parents/carers of some important dates relating to the Sixth Form.

- Year 12 Students will continue to attend all lessons during the exam period (Thursday 5th May – Wednesday 15th June) although they are permitted to remain at home in the morning to prepare for afternoon examinations. Should a student have a lesson in the examined subject during the morning they are expected to attend as normal. Subject teachers may also be available for further revision sessions at other times and students should arrange individual tutorials as appropriate.
- Level 3 BTEC students must continue to attend lessons and all mandatory units must be completed and submitted by Friday 8th July 2016.
- Students are required to achieve a D grade or higher in AS examinations and at least a Pass in BTEC subjects in order to guarantee progression to Year 13. It is recommended that students endeavor to complete their work to the highest possible standard in BTEC subjects as there is no opportunity to re-visit these units in Year 13.

Post Examination Information

From Monday 4th July 2016 until Wednesday 6th July 2016 all Year 12 students will be involved in Future Options activities. Presentations and workshops led by outside agencies and school staff, will support students with their progression to higher education, apprenticeship schemes or into the workplace. Parents/carers are invited to attend an information evening on Monday 4th July at the conclusion of this event.

All Year 12 students are encouraged to participate in the SWR 40th Anniversary celebrations during the week commencing 11th July 2016 which includes the opportunity to visit Brighton on a day trip. Further information and consent forms are available on the school website.

Any students who have yet to complete the required paperwork for their work experience are reminded that this is now urgent and should be completed as a priority.

AS results will be available in the main Reception area of the school on Thursday 18th August 2016 from 9.30am. Alternatively, students can collect their results at the start of term.

The new school year for **Year 13** begins on **Tuesday 6th September 2016 at 8.30 am.**
