Hair up/back  
Light day make up

**PE:**

Navy tracksuit trousers  
Navy shorts  
Light blue polo shirt  
Hair up/back

At present, we have a number of students who are not adhering to the Sixth Form dress code. Girls in particular are wearing skirts and dresses that are not an acceptable length and are not appropriate for the school/business environment. Unfortunately, every day, it has been necessary for both me and Mrs Aldred to approach girls about their skirts so we are having to draw a line.
