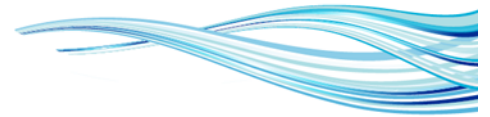

Numeracy Homework KS3 & KS4

All students in KS3 & KS4 will have numeracy homework set on MyMaths. The school login details for MyMaths are as follows:

Students are in the process of being given their personalised MyMaths logins so that they can complete their tasks.

Each half term students will be set 7 or 8 tasks, consisting of 5 smaller online homeworks with 2 parts and 2 larger online worksheets with 4 parts. Students will be given the half term to complete these tasks as and when they choose. Students will be given weekly reminders both on SMHW and in their first Maths lesson of each week.
