CURRICULUM OVERVEWS: To aid parents in understanding what is being taught across the school each department has added a curriculum overview onto their part of the school's website. This gives information on topics taught for each year group, for each half term and for every subject. These will all be accessible by half term. We hope parents/carers and students will find them helpful.

The school's BTEC PSD (Personal and Social Development) Group is currently raising money for a wheelchair accessible bench. PSD is a life skills course to support young people in gaining confidence in either physical or social situations by taking on challenges that they may otherwise have difficulty with. For example: getting on a bus and buying their ticket, interview techniques, banking and budgeting money, community support and fundraising.



SWR has a PD-ARP (Additionally Resourced Provision), which means we are a centre for students with physical disabilities. By raising money for a wheelchair accessible bench, our students with wheelchairs will have the same opportunities as the rest of the students to sit outside with their friends at break and lunch.
