



Uniform information

- Blazers must be worn by all students during lessons and should only be removed when teaching staff have advised it is okay to do so. Blazers should be worn appropriately (sleeves not rolled up etc)
- Trainers are not to be worn during lessons and only at break and lunch if students are playing sport on the school field/hardcourts. School shoes should be black in colour and should not display a logo.
- Hoodies, jumpers and coats should be worn over blazers when the weather is cold and removed for all lessons.
- School jumpers and cardigans may be worn under blazers but if the student is feeling hot the jumper/cardigan should be removed and the blazer worn over the shirt.
- Students are expected to wear a school tie at all times. This should be worn displaying the school badge and with the top button on the shirt/blouse done up.
- No visible piercings or jewellery are permitted in school. Any students with piercings should be asked to remove them and the item of jewellery kept by staff. If a student refuses to remove jewellery they should be directed to the Pastoral department. Students may wear a wrist watch.
- Hair should be no shorter than a grade 2 cut and should be a natural colour. Students that do not have appropriate hair colour or style should be directed to the Pastoral Department. No patterns should be cut/shaved into students hair or eyebrows.
- Nail polish is not permitted and students should be asked to remove it.
- Students may bring phones to school but if they are seen using them during the school day the phone will be confiscated by the class teacher. This can then be placed in the school safe for collection by an adult or returned to the student at the end of the school day.
- Students are expected to have appropriate equipment for learning on them in school (pens, pencils, calculator etc)
- Students are expected to have a student planner in all lessons.
- Any student that fails to meet the expectations for uniform will work in Student Support for the day and a call home will be made to request that uniform items are purchased as a matter of urgency. Uniform passes may be issued by Pastoral Managers for trainers, missing tie or missing blazer in exceptional circumstances and only for a limited period of time. A call home will also be made in relation to this.
