COVID-19 Home School Agreement

SCHOOL

The school aims to:

- ◆ Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;
- ◆ Adhere to guidance as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can;
- ◆ Contact parents/carers immediately if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;
- ◆ Inform parents/carers if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' has a confirmed case of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until your test comes back negative;
- ◆ Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children, as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well as the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- ◆ Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, emails and the school website.

PARENT / CARER

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- ◆ I will go through this agreement with them, checking their understanding of it;
- ◆ I will check my child for symptoms prior to leaving for school, including checking their temperature;
- ◆ I will ensure that my child knows what COVID-19 symptoms are;
- ◆ If my child or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, get tested and self-isolate until the results are received. I will let the school know the results as soon as possible via email office@swr.school;
- ◆ If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school **immediately**;
- ◆ I will ensure that my child brings a full water bottle (there will be no facility to refill it in school), pen, pencil, ruler, rubber, pencil sharpener, glue stick, calculator and round tipped scissors so equipment is not shared;
- ◆ I will remind my child about the 2m social distancing rules and ensure that they know what 2m looks like in reality;
- ◆ I will ensure that my child knows about safe travel to and from school, including the rules for public transport;
- ◆ My child will know how to use good respiratory and hand hygiene. I will provide my child with hand sanitiser and a packet of tissues;
- ◆ I will not be allowed into the school without a prearranged appointment – make appointments via email;
- ◆ I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis;
- ◆ I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- ◆ I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details;
- ◆ If my child is deemed unsafe, I accept that they will be excluded from school.

STUDENT

I will:

- ◆ Comply with all rules as they are there to keep me and my school community safe;
- ◆ Move around school as instructed and not stray from my year group's bubble areas;
- ◆ Tell a member of staff if I feel unwell;
- ◆ Bring a full water bottle, pen, pencil, ruler, rubber, pencil sharpener, glue stick, calculator and round tipped scissors, as equipment is not shared;
- ◆ Bring hand sanitiser and pocket tissues each day;
- ◆ Wear my full school uniform;
- ◆ Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it, bin it, kill it) and avoiding touching my mouth, nose and hands;
- ◆ Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/hand sanitiser;
- ◆ Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
- ◆ Not cough, spit at or sneeze towards others;
- ◆ Follow these expectations and know that if I do not, I will be excluded from school and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe;
- ◆ Travel safely to and from school following the rules of public transport.
